LIABILITY INSURANCE

Exhibitors must file proof of General Liability Insurance in the amount of not less than two million, naming Paris Agricultural Society as an additional insured with the Office. **NOTE: This must be received prior to setup or setup will not be allowed.**

DECISIONS OF THE SOCIETY

Applications are subject to approval by PAS Christmas Display. Organizers reserve the right to prohibit the display and/or distribution of materials it deems illegal, obscene or offensive. Organizers may limit the number and location of "same kind" vendors. All decisions are final. Preference will be given to returning vendors.

EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES

- No open fires.
- Exhibitors must confine their exhibit within the limits of their allotted space. **Roaming characters/persons are restricted to only those who have provided a detailed description of their costumes, intended activities and personal protective plans and have been approved by the PAS Christmas Display committee.**
- No alcohol or cannabis products may be brought to, or consumed in, exhibit space.
- Tables, chairs, lamps, hydro, extension cords or tarps are not provided. **If the exhibit or display/float requires hydro, the exhibitor must supply their own generator or source of power.**
- Tents, displays and products must be secured in the event of inclement weather including high winds.

SET UP AND MOVE OUT

- Exhibitors and their committees may access the fairgrounds at 9am on Saturday December 5th. A PAS Committee member will provide direction to the designated exhibit spot.
- **All Exhibit set up must be complete by 3:30pm.**
- Washroom and Break facilities will be available for those assisting with set up of the exhibits.
- **Exhibits must remain intact until 8:00pm December 5th.**
- All Exhibits must be removed in their entirety by 10pm December 5th. Overnight security WILL NOT be available for any portion of exhibits left after 10pm.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

On behalf of the Exhibitor, I shall indemnify and hold harmless the Paris Agricultural Society, their members, volunteers and employees from and against all claims, demands, losses, actions, suits or proceedings by any third parties that may arise out of, or may attribute to all operations performed by or carried out by the exhibitor, his agents, employees, or servants or anyone for whose acts he may be held liable howsoever caused.

The Exhibitor agrees that if and whenever and to the extent that the PAS may be prevented, delayed or restricted in whole or in part from holding this event by reason of any cause beyond the control of the PAS including, without limitation, strikes or work stoppages, Acts of God, pandemic or public health emergency or the passing of any statute law or regulation, the PAS shall have no responsibility for any loss or damages sustained by the Exhibitor.
