



## **PARIS FAIRGROUNDS RE-OPENING MARCH 1, 2021 ORANGE “RESTRICT” ZONE**

The facilities and grounds owned by the Paris Agricultural Society will re-open on March 1, 2021 in accordance with public health measures. All guidelines and restrictions will be strictly followed and we will continue to monitor for announcements regarding changes in the expectations and requirements.

Rental parties and their invited visitors can be assured that their health and safety is our number one priority. The following protocols will be followed upon re-opening:

- a) Staff and volunteers must complete Screening Questions as recommended from the Ministry of Labour prior to each shift. They must wash their hands before and after contact with others as well as wear a face covering when working with customers or other staff/volunteers inside.
  
- b) All contact surfaces, including high touch areas such as door handle and equipment knobs will be washed, rinsed and sanitized before and after each rental/use of the facility. Cleaning and disinfection will be documented.
  
- d) Hand washing stations and washrooms will be functional and fully stocked.
  
- e) Hand sanitizing stations will be set at every entry to the buildings.
  
- f) Rooms and hallways will be configured in accordance with social distancing requirements.
  
- g) Directional signage and barriers will be installed when necessary to protect staff and visitors.
